Fiscal year 21, transportation hired a contracting company through the bidding process to remove and dispose of an existing bridge and construct a new bridge 60 feet long. This bridge was condemned after an inspection and needed to be replaced right away due to school buses using it yearly and the farmers and ranchers in the area. Transportation also received a grant to replace 2.5 miles of existing fencing with new Type F4W fencing along a road called Joe Show Road West. The replacement of this fencing will keep livestock off of highway 89 and eliminate major accidents. This project is in the final stages and the final report was sent through the system with the project portion of the report. In FY 20 we received two safety grants but was unable to complete them due to the COVID outbreak. It wasn't until this year we were finally able to complete the required process to close out these two grants. The first grant was to update the Transportation Safety Plan, which has been completed. Second grant was to do a Road Safety Audit, which has also been completed and the highway selected is a high risk roadway for livestock and accidents. The final report is still underway. These activities are just a few of the safety projects we have completed.

Due to COVID-19, and as per Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes' Executive Order, the Safety Division of the Tribes' Department of Transportation did furlough staff for the period of March 2020 through January 2021. During said time, only essential staff remained active status therefore the Safety Division was reorganized based on revisions to various Job Descriptions by combining job duties and tasks and further adding duties as per the Tribes' COVID-19 precautions. The Safety Division did have a Highway Safety Officer that remained active status as an essential employee of the Tribes to administer and patrol the Tribes' service area and continue to cite individuals for violation of various Tribal laws were applicable, including operation of motor vehicles, occupant protection (seatbelts), and pedestrian safety. However, due to COVID-19, the Safety Division was unable to collect pertinent data related to DUIs and Car Seats to further pursue various Transportation Safety Grants. Minimal progress was made in the area of pedestrian, motorist, and occupancy safety. Due to COVID-19, the Tribes' Transportation Safety Program is working on developing different and innovative ways to interact with Tribal members to improve transportation safety and educate Tribal membe

Phase 1 and Phase 2 of the project consisted of the following tasks 1) Develop a GIS Mapping Environment to Support Analysis, 2) Perform Analysis and Develop Finding Tables and Support Narratives, 3) Research and Collect Existing Transportation Safety Data, 4) Develop Presentation & Present Findings, and 5) Develop Tribal Transportation Safety Goals and Plan. The total anticipated costs for the project are \$7,485.25 for Phase 1 and \$5,014.75 for Phase 2. After working with Mr. Lewis and his staff, and compiling a lot of the safety information necessary for the data analysis in the plan, Phase 1 of the project was completed last Fiscal Year. As mentioned in the previous Semi-Annual Report, we would carry over the remaining funds into this Fiscal Year to cover final expenses for Phase 2 of the project. After completion of Phase 2 of the project, Red Plain's submitted the final Safety Plan Report. Total expenses for Phase 2 was issued in the amount of \$5,014.75, right in line with ou

The CMS program, right now, also oversees the closeout of the Lenore Bridge Approaches project and the Burris-Lenore Road ERFO MP 1.9 & MP 2.1 projects. To note, the Lenore Bridge Approaches project was a project to complete the Lenore Bridge Project (approx. a \$2.5 million dollar project, see attached photo). Another major focus of CMS is the administration of the following pre-construction projects with detailed updates:Driskell Lane: 30% Plan Set is complete. Surveyors completed topographic survey, utility locates, and corner points. Design is 55% complete. R.O.W. maps and ROW acquisition are in the initial stages. A stake holders meeting was held September 28th-29th and a field visit. Archeological and Environmental service (KLJ) started the field work. Due to limited resources and personnel within the Roads & Transportation Department, much of the maintenance work over the past twelve months has been attributed to Northern Pueblos Agency's Darryl Baca, who routinely came out and graded our earth and gravel roads, mowed overgrown shoulders, trimmed overgrown trees, etc. Unfortunately, Mr. Baca is stretched pretty thin a lot of the time conducting maintenance work for three other Pueblos, so in order to supplement a lot of the work that he doesn't have time to do, the following expenditures have been made. In March, Roads & Transportation Staff purchased some sign installation equipment, as well as some signage and posts, from Highway Supply for a total price of \$4,719.54. The signage was used to replace missing or damaged signage along BIA Route 102 Section 10, Route 109 Section 10, and Route 101 Section 60. . In June, August, and September, Roads & Transportation Staff purchased some minor equipment from Lowes for a total price of \$1,837.69.
