2 – Suspected serious/incapacitating	A	Used when any injury, other than a fatal injury, that prevents the injured person from walking, driving, or normally continuing the activities the person was capable of before the injury occurred. This includes severe lacerations (exposure of underlying tissues/muscle/organs or resulting in significant loss of blood); broken or distorted limbs (arm or leg); skull, chest injuries or abdominal injuries other than bruises or minor lacerations; crush injuries; significant burns (second and third degree burns over 10 percent or more of the body); unconsciousness at or when taken from the crash scene; and unable to leave the crash scene without assistance (paralysis). 2 – Incapacitating Injury	A	Incapacitating: Any injury, other than a fatal injury, which prevents the injured person from walking, driving or normally continuing the activities the person was capable of performing before the injury occurred.
