Located along the South Entrance Road, this project includes construction of a double span 357-foot long steel girder bridge, 3 mechanically stabilized earth walls, removal of existing Lewis River Bridge, stone masonry, excavation, and paving.

Construction has begun for the 2024 season this week. The contractor moved snow to create work space and started building bridge deck falsework. Bridge girder survey was also completed.

Upcoming work includes: bridge deck falsework, concrete formwork, stone masonry, and MSE wall installation.
