The contractor worked on installing culvert crossings and paving the temporary bridge approaches to the new bridge, prepping for the transition of public traffic soon. The bridge subcontractor has upstream side of the bridge railing installed. Upcoming work includes more pavement removal, roadway excavation, select borrow backfill, and culvert installations. Be mindful of the rock trucks being used throughout the project site.
