Project Description:

This project is being administered by the Federal Highway Administration Western Federal Lands Highway Division, in partnership with Flathead National Forest, US Border Patrol and Flathead County. The project will provide an improved travel surface and replacement of existing culverts on sections of Belton Stage Road, Blankenship Road, the last 5 miles of North Fork Road and Glacier Drive between Polebridge and Polebridge Ranger Station in Glacier National Park.


Surface Conditions:

At Polebridge, road conditions are subgrade millings being laid to bring elevation up. Areas of uneven surface as material continues to be placed. The North Fork Road conditions are dirt roadway with ruts and potholes in areas as the contractor begins to work roadway in preparation for material to be placed in coming weeks.

Traffic Delays:

The contractor continues work on both North Fork Road and Polebridge. Expect delays up to 30 minutes at either work site. Trucks will be hauling material from Demers Pit north to Polebridge and from Whale Creek to North Fork road. Please abide by signage for both motorist and pedestrians.
