This project will reconstruct 13.97 miles of Shields River Road to include full depth reclamation, aggregate base, 3-inches of new asphalt surfacing, new pavement markings and 3,550 feet of new guardrail.

September 6, 2024

Aggregate placement has been completed to approx. MP 7.0. The reclaimer has completed pulverizing the road base and aggregate to approx. MP 4.5.

Upcoming Construction Activities:

Aggregate placement and full depth reclamation will continue working north. Approx. 20,000 more tons of aggregate base is scheduled to be hauled from Livingston to the project over the next two weeks.

Please be careful and watch for large trucks hauling gravel in the area.
