Project Description

Utilizing Great American Outdoor Act Funding, the Lewis River Bridge project, located along the South Entrance Road, includes construction of a double span 357-foot long steel girder bridge, 3 mechanically stabilized earth walls, removal of the existing Lewis River Bridge, stone masonry, excavation, and paving.

Work Schedule

The contractor completed sidewalk concrete. They continue stone masonry work on the South wall, placing topsoil around sidewalks, and general project clean up.

Upcoming work includes: South wall and guardwall stonework, asphalt paving, striping, and permanent signage.



Traffic Delays
