Project Description

Utilizing Great American Outdoor Act Funding, the Lewis River Bridge project, located along the South Entrance Road, includes construction of a double span 357-foot long steel girder bridge, 3 mechanically stabilized earth walls, removal of the existing Lewis River Bridge, stone masonry, excavation, and paving.



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Work Schedule



Tuesday, 05/27/25, is the first working day on site of the season.

The contractor is working on final work items such as concrete sidewalks, and removing the South Guardwall concrete for replacement.

Upcoming work includes: removal and replacement of the guardwall, concrete sidewalks, stonework, striping, and permanent signage. The added corrective work on the South MSE Wall will most likely extend the construction period.



Traffic Delays

Warning - Anticipate up to 10 minute delays during construction activities. There is a single lane, two-way alternating temporary traffic control zone. Please observe and heed the temporary traffic signals. The speed limit continues to be 25 mph.
