

Construction Activities & Upcoming Work

Inland Crane, Inc. (ICI) has completed the placement of the up stream Abutment 1 anchor block and Permanent Ground Anchor (PGAs). ICI continues working on the down stream Abutment 1 anchor block PGAs, with the completion of the proof testing taking place early next week. Once the testing is completed and results reviewed ICI will trim the PGA tendons off and cap them. In the coming week ICI will start placing additional reinforcing steel and formwork for Abutment 1 concrete pour #3. This pour will enclose the Abutment 1 Anchor block cable connections into vaults for protection and could not be completed until all PGA work was completed.

Please Use Caution when traveling and be aware of oncoming traffic, during day, night, weekdays, and weekends. It continues to be a single traffic lane through the construction site at the Crane Tower. Concrete barriers has been installed to protect the traveling public and the project site. The speed limit continues to be 15mph thru this area during the 2025 Construction Season. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.
