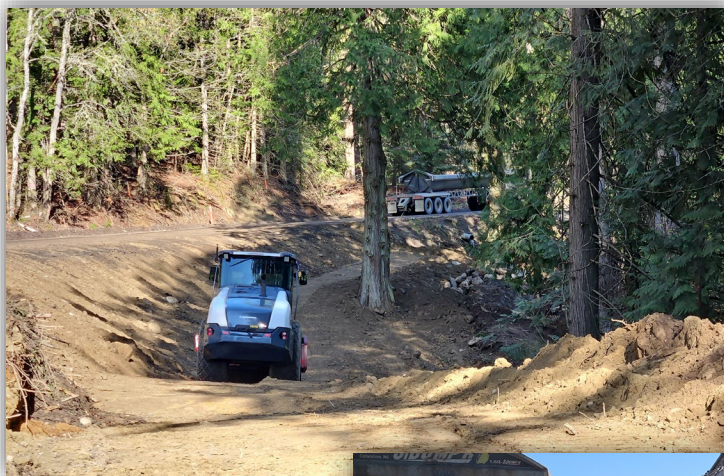

The contractor will be continuing excavation and embankment work between Lions Den and the refuge headquarters, with one-lane traffic controlled by stoplights. Excavation and embankment work will also be active along Riverside Road.

Upcoming Construction Activities:

Geofabric and geogrid installation along Riverside Road will be ongoing.



Work Schedule:

Monday- Friday: 6 :00 am – 5:00 pm

Delays and Closures: (Please Have Patience During Construction)

Riverside Road from Lions Den Road to Deep Creek Bridge will be closed **to all traffic** March 30th to October 30th.

Westside Road from Lions Den Road to the Kootenai Wildlife Refuge Center will be under single lane closures during tree clearing operations. Delays of up to 30 minutes can be expected.
