Project Description

Located on the South Entrance Road, this project includes construction of a double span 357-foot long steel girder bridge, 3 mechanically stabilized earth walls, removal of the existing Lewis River Bridge, stone masonry, roadway excavation, and paving.

Work Schedule

Expect work 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday.



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This week the contractor is digging material from abutment 2 piles, and started construction on the falsework for the pier.

Upcoming work includes: Abutment 1 pile welding, falsework for the pier, pile dig out, and concrete pour for the piles.



Traffic Delays

Anticipate up to 15 minute delays during construction activities. There will be a one-lane, two-way temporary traffic control zone
