The next step in the process will be to develop project agreements between Eastern Federal Lands Highway Division and the State/Local Agency partners. Funding beyond 2014 is dependent on reauthorization of the Access Program by Congress. The Kentucky PDC does not have a firm date for the next call for projects under the Access Program, but another call is anticipated within the next year.
