KEY MILESTONES

NORTH FORK ROAD

- Resurfacing from the Whale Creek Bridge approximately eight miles north of Polebridge for 7.7 miles (MP 42.3 to 50.0) to provide a 22-foot wide roadway;
- Reconstruction from the end of the resurfacing section for 5.1 miles to the Canadian Border (MP 50.0 to 55.15) to provide a 22-foot wide roadway;
- Reconstruction/slope stabilization at an area of erosion along the river approximately 10.5 miles north of Polebridge (MP 44.53); and
- Slope stabilization at Wurtz Hill approximately 12.4 miles north of Polebridge (MP 46.58).

GLACIER DRIVE AND POLEBRIDGE LOOP

- Reconstruction of Glacier Drive for 1.3
 miles from the end of the Polebridge
 Bridge to the intersection with Polebridge
 Loop (MP 0.2 to 1.5) to provide a 22-foot
 wide roadway; and
- Reconstruction of Polebridge Loop for 0.3 miles from the intersection with Glacier Drive to the North Fork Road (MP 1.5 to 1.84) to provide a 22-foot wide roadway.


